



Easy D.I.Y. Cupcake Stands

To complete this project you will need:

- Colored Wool Blend Felt
- Tacky Glue
- An unopened canned item
- Two circles (9" dia. max.) cut from $\frac{3}{8}$ " thick foamboard or cardboard
- Scrapbook paper (optional)
- Hot melt glue gun & glue sticks

STEP 1:



Cut a rectangle of felt that is as high as the can and long enough to wrap around the can once, with a little extra to overlap. I used pinking shears to create a decorative edge to the wrap, but you can just cut it straight.

STEP 2:



Wrap the felt rectangle around the can, making sure to line up the top and bottom edges. Glue it to the can label with tacky glue, pressing the overlapped edge firmly together.

STEP 3:



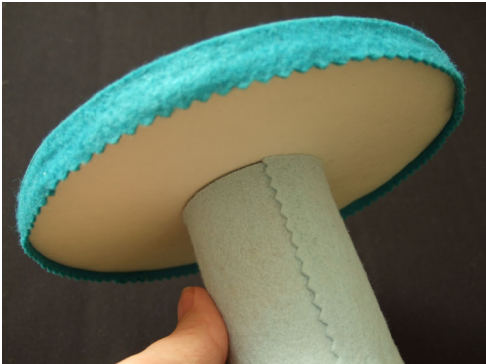
Cut a circle of felt the same size as the circles. Glue the two foamboard or cardboard circles back-to-back and when dry, glue the felt piece to the top surface. (If you cannot get a big enough piece of felt you can use a circle cut from a pretty sheet of scrapbook paper.)

STEP 4:



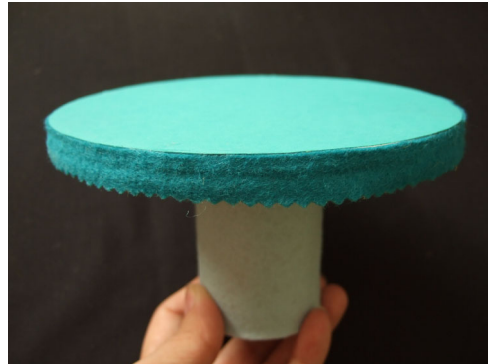
Cut one or more strips of felt $\frac{1}{2}$ " wide and long enough to wrap around the edge of the top. I cut one edge of mine with pinking shears. Glue the strip(s) to the perimeter of the circle assembly, making sure to line up the plain edge flush with the top edge.

STEP 5:



Using a big glob of hot melt glue, attach one end of the base to the center of the underside of the top.

Ta Daaa!



I made about 6 or 7 of these in all different sizes. I stacked them up on each other to create multi-level stands for mini cupcakes, truffles, and other small treats.
